New Vocabulary

Scale: A drawing (recipe) that has been reduced or enlarged from its original size to a specified scale.

*Example: If **One** strawberry shake cost \$.25 to make. (We need strawberries, ice cream, whip cream and cherries.)*

*Then, **One Hundred** strawberry shakes will cost me \$25.00 to make.*

Profit: The amount of money made by a business that is more than the amount put in at the start or paid out as expenses.
